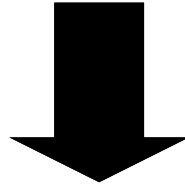


R.E AT THE WEST LONDON PRIMARY CLUSTER

Lesson will be planned with the six macro concepts in mind by incorporating key Tier 2 and Tier 3 vocabulary.

Learners complete Pop Quizzes regularly to ensure their key knowledge is recalled and embedded in the long term memory.

Early Morning Learning gives learners and opportunity to revisit knowledge taught in previous year groups.
